Cambodian Long Grain White Rice



Assessment Principles

Quality: Please see overleaf.

Current crop. Weight, Quality, and Fumigation final at loading as per certificates issued by a First Class Superintendent Company.

Sortexing: All prices are for sortexed quality.

Quantity: 100 MTS - 1,000 MTS +/- 5% at seller's option.

Packing: In new single white woven polypropylene bags each of 50kg net shipped weight, with buyer's marks. Minimum tare weight of 110g.

Basis: USD PMT net shipped weight FOB load port in 20' containers.

Shipment period: 15 - 45 days after publication date.

Load port: Sihanoukville or Phnom Penh Port.

Payment: By confirmed irrevocable Letter of Credit payable at sight, opened by a prime international bank. Confirmation charges for buyer's account.

Documentation: Standard shipping documents (+ EUR1/Certificate of origin for E.U. shipments).

Load Rate: 24 MTS per FCL.

Insurance: For buyer's account.

All other terms when not in contradiction with the above as per London Rice Brokers' Association Standard Contract Terms (September 1997), amended 1st November 2008. English law to apply.

Normalisation: Where appropriate, contracts, offers and bids which vary from the above quality and terms, will be normalised to this standard.

Definitions

Whole Kernels – Kernels of rice without broken parts or broken kernels which are at least 9/10 of the whole kernel in length.

Head Rice – A kernel of rice which is greater than 8/10 but shorter than whole kernels in length.

Broken Rice – A fragment of rice kernel which is greater than 25% of a whole kernel but less than head rice.

Small Broken Rice – A fragment of rice kernel which passes through a sieve with a round perforation 1.75mm in diameter.

Damaged Kernels – Whole or fragmented rice kernels distinctly damaged or discolored by heat, moisture, fungi, insects or other causes.

Foreign Matter – All matter other than rice or paddy rice, such as soil, gravel, fragment of panicle, dirt, husk and insect.

Yellow Kernels – Whole or broken kernels which have turned from their natural colour to a yellow colour.

Chalky Kernels – Whole rice kernels (except for waxy rice) or 3/4 of the surface of which has an opaque and floury appearance.

Immature Kernels – Rice kernels that are light green, which is obtained from milling immature paddy.

Red Streaked Kernels – Rice kernels with red streaks covering at least 5/10 of the whole kernel in average length.

Paddy – A kernel of rice which has retained its husk after threshing.

Well Milled – Paddy rice which has had its husk, germ and bran removed to the extent that the rice kernel is translucent but not as translucent as extra well milled.

For all other specifications and definitions, where they do not conflict with the above, see 'Cambodian Standards CS 053:2012'. Testing of these specifications is as per 'Cambodian Standards CS 001:2000' and 'Cambodian Standards CS 085:2010'.
